To create a custom color scheme:

1. On the **Articulate** tab, click the **Player Templates** button.
2. Click the **Colors** tab.
3. Click the **Edit Color Schemes** button.
4. Click the **New** button.
5. Type the name of your color scheme.
6. Click **OK**.
7. Select the radio button for the color element you wish to change.
8. Select or create the color you want.
9. Click the **Apply This Color** button to preview and select the result.
10. Repeat steps 7-9 for any other screen elements you want to change.
11. Click **OK** in the top right corner.
